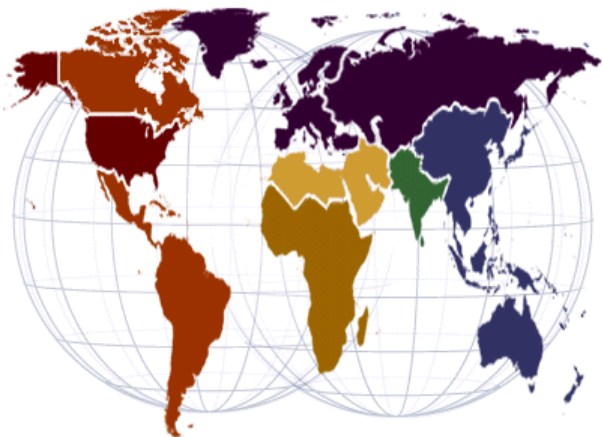

The Development Fund of the International Federation for Home Economics in the United States (IFHE-US) was started in 1996. IFHE-US is a 501 (c) 3 not-for-profit organization.

The purpose of the fund is to raise money for home economics related projects in developing countries, so that grants may be awarded to these deserving projects.



Administrative costs of the Fund are in-kind contributions, so all financial contributions are invested in full and only investment interest income is used for grants. The first grant was a Banana Artistry project in St. Lucia in 2004. Other grants in Kenya, South Africa, and St. Thomas have been to assist refugees and AIDS orphans, reduce pollution, and conserve fuel.



You can bequeath a fixed dollar amount or a percentage of your estate. Your legal counsel can add an amendment to your current Will or Living Trust, if you choose to include the IFHE-US Development Fund in your estate plans.

Another option would be to list the IFHE-US Development Fund as a beneficiary of a retirement account or life insurance policy.

All contributions and gifts are deductible for federal income, estate, and gift tax purposes. Your support can make a difference for many years.
