What is IFHE?

The International Federation for Home Economics is the only worldwide organization concerned with Home Economics and Consumer Studies. It was founded in 1908 to serve as a platform for international exchange within the field of Home Economics.

IFHE is an International Non Governmental Organization (INGO) in consultative status with the United Nations (ECOSOC, FAO, UNESCO, UNICEF) and with the Council of Europe.

How IFHE works

About 1500 Individuals and 150 Organizations in more than 50 countries all over the world are organized in the IFHE.

The Council consists of member representatives (delegates) and the Executive Committee. The Council meets every two years. It is responsible for defining the program of work for IFHE.

The Executive Committee (EC) is responsible for implementing the program of work. The EC consists of the President, the Treasurer and two elected representatives of each region (Africa, America, Asia, Europe and Pacific). The EC meets once a year.

The Secretary General deals with the administration and organization of IFHE. It is located in Bonn, Germany.

All members are invited to participate in topic-related **Program Committees**.

IFHE-US

IFHE-US is a 501 c 3 not for profit organization incorporated in the United States to serve as the affiliate unit of IFHE in the United States. IFHE-US is governed by a Board of Directors elected from the membership. Annual meetings are held in conjunction with AAFCS Annual Conferences. Membership dues to IFHE-US include membership in the International Federation plus membership in the IFHE-US. Two newsletters are produced annually and sent to members. In addition, information to keep members informed is available on the IFHE-US.ORG website. IFHE-US manages a Development Fund aimed at supporting home economics programs in developing countries.
